SENIOR MENS LOW GROSS TOURNAMENT RULES

The tournament will be played using the accumulated gross scores of the players in two 18 hole matches on dates approved by the club. The tournament will be by stroke play as defined by the RCGA Rules of Golf in current use. The field of players will be divided into three flights based on their handicaps as recorded by the Club's computer.

Flight '1' for players with handicaps from 0 to 16.

Flight '2' for players with handicaps from 17 to 21.

Flight '3' for players with handicaps from 22 and over.

The winner of each flight will be the player recording the lowest gross score who has in the current year played a minimum of 12 rounds during the regular Wednesday Club games and recorded on the Club's computer before the date of the tournament.

Ties at the end of the round in flights "2" and "3" will be decided by regression.

A tie at the end of the round in Flight" 1" will be decided in a three-hole playoff. If it is still tied, then the players will continue in a sudden death playoff.

The "1" flight winner will be declared Club
