Re Dr. Sadar Update and Announcement

The Charity committee received an update from Dr. Sadar with exciting news. Covid may have affected our fund raising ability but it certainly hasn't stopped their ongoing prostate cancer research.

1 - The results of the clinical trial for EPI-7386 should be available in October
"Here the research is going well. The clinical trial with EPI-7386 is still ongoing in the USA and Canada. Clinical data is expected to be released from the company on Oct 5-7, 2021. Fingers crossed that men are responding to the treatment."

2- Dr. Sadar, her lab and 2 Co-investigators received a 5 year, \$2.2M research grant.

"In terms of my research with these drugs, we received a large grant from the USA (top 9 % of all applications) to develop imaging agents to detect metastatic lesions in men with prostate cancer." Analysis of these can be used to determine the most effect course of treatment. "The grant involves a number of scientists including a chemist, radiochemist/imaging, X-ray crystallographer and CryoEM expert, and me – a prostate cancer/ androgen receptor/ V7 expert."

As requested, she also provided us with a list of items that we can help with that will assist their lab with continuing prostate cancer research. They still appreciate and need our support.

Thanks to all of you who continue to provide that support.
